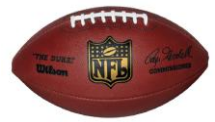

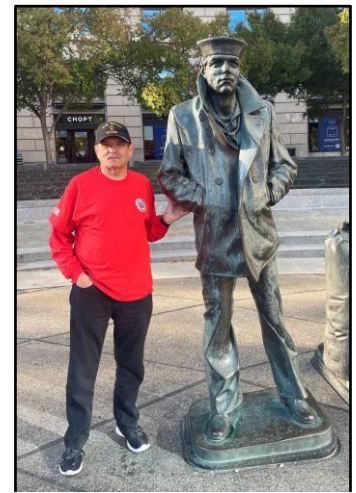

David & Patrick traveled together on the latest Southern Tier Honor Flight trip to Washington D.C. Patrick's story illustrates how deeply meaningful Honor Flights are to the Veterans.

From Patrick:

I had an amazing time being my father's Guardian during the Honor Flight trip to D.C. I grew up hearing stories of his time in the Navy, from the Mediterranean Sea, New Zealand, Antarctica, and even during the Cuban Missile Crisis! These stories led me to join the military as well and that is a big connection in my family, as we have had someone serving in the military since WWI. Taking this trip with him and being surrounded by so many others who served was truly an Honor!

We had a police escort to and from the Legion to the PA border, which I thought was an awesome show of support. On the way back the team handed out letters from local school children to the Vets and played a number of patriotic songs. I was surprised to learn that Johnny Cash's song "Ragged Old Flag" was written on the Binghamton Court House steps, (1974) after having a discussion with a Veteran. We arrived back to Post 1645 to find a huge crowd of family, friends, and supporters. It was a great "Welcome Home!"

Thank you so much for all those who put this trip together and who helped make lasting memories for us all!

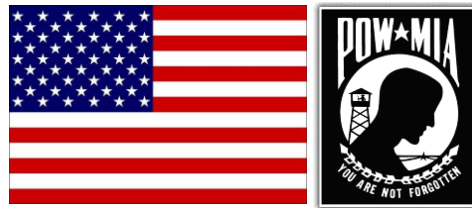
